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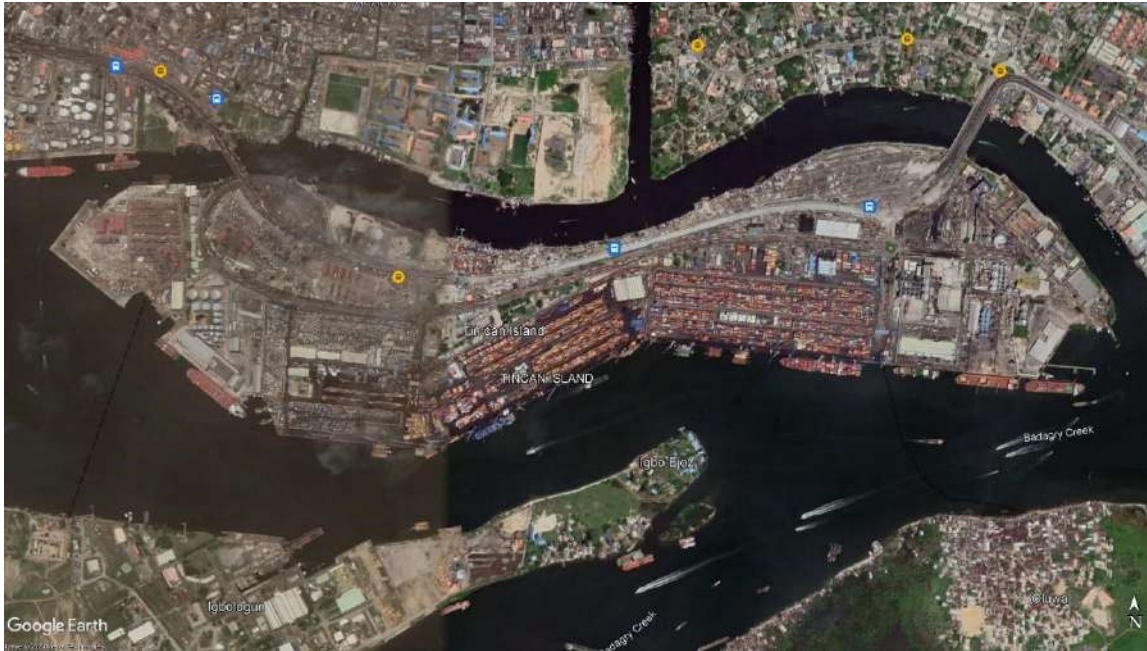

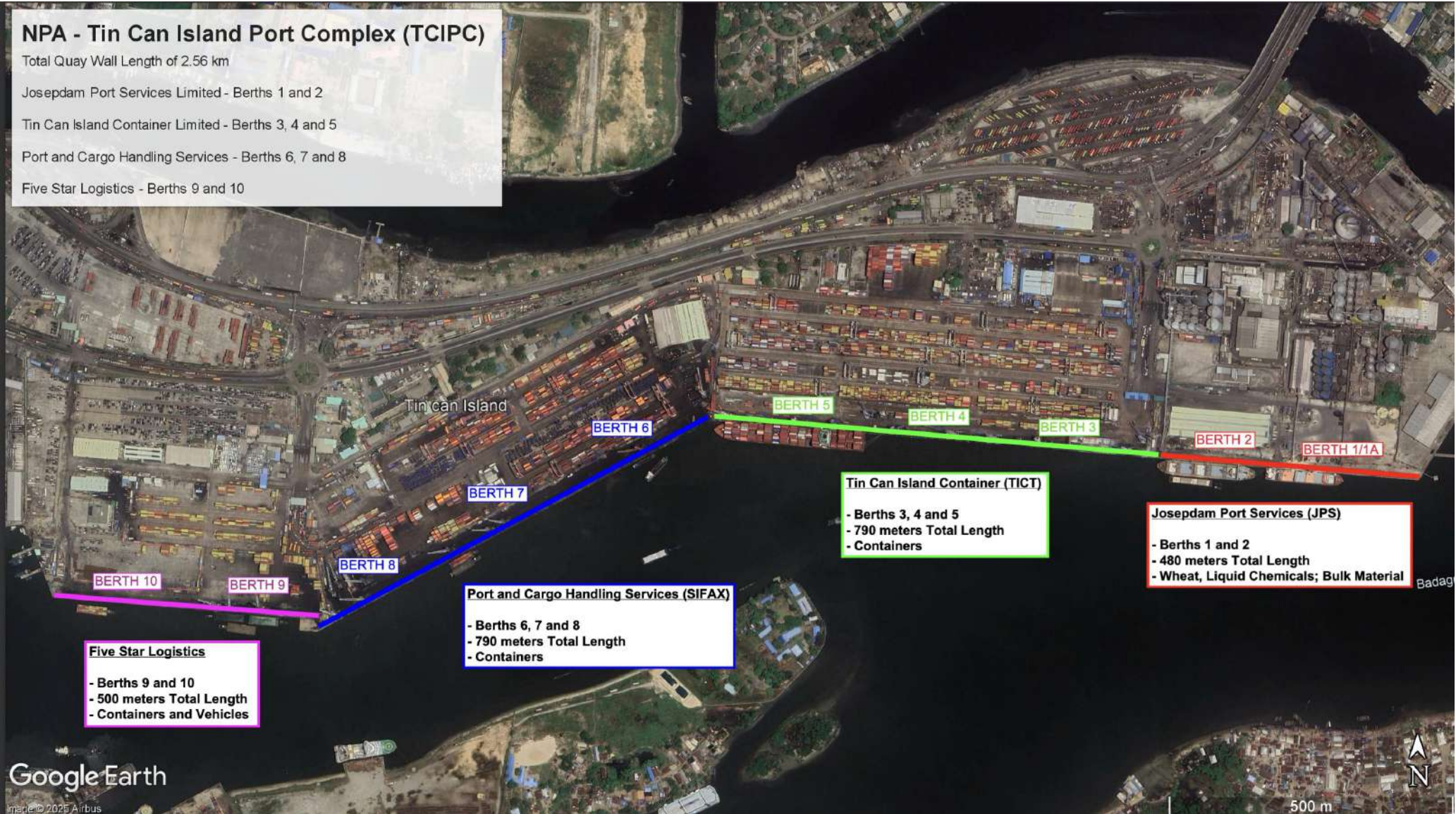


Lagos Apapa Port Complex

Tin Can Island Port Complex Current State

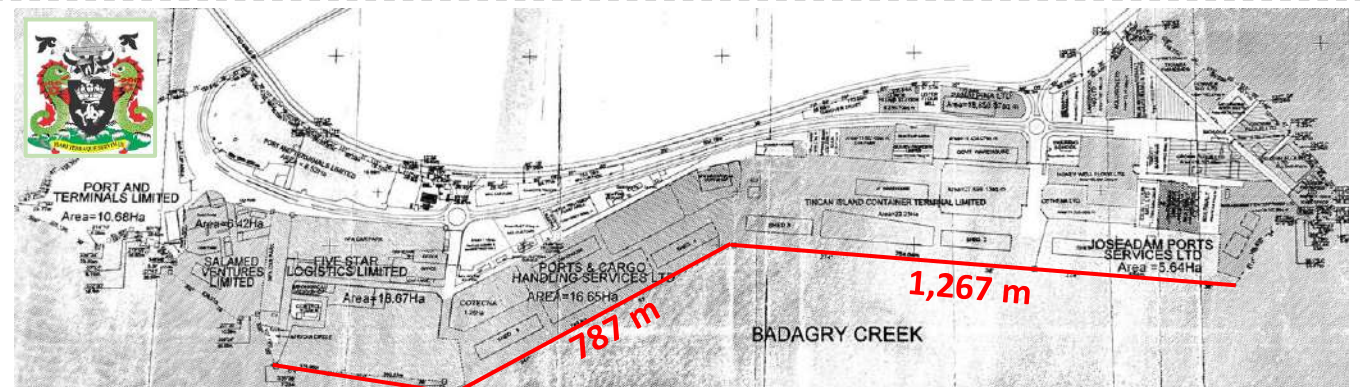
The **Tin Can Island Port Complex (TCIPC)** was Commissioned in **1977** with a capacity of **handling 10-16 vessels at a time**. The Quay Wall Structure is based on **Steel Sheet Piles with Tie-Back Anchors supported by Embedded Steel Columns**.

Following 47 Years of Operation, the Quay Wall Structure is **showing Signs of Fatigue due to the Corrosion of the Steel SPW and Erosion of the Retained Soil**.



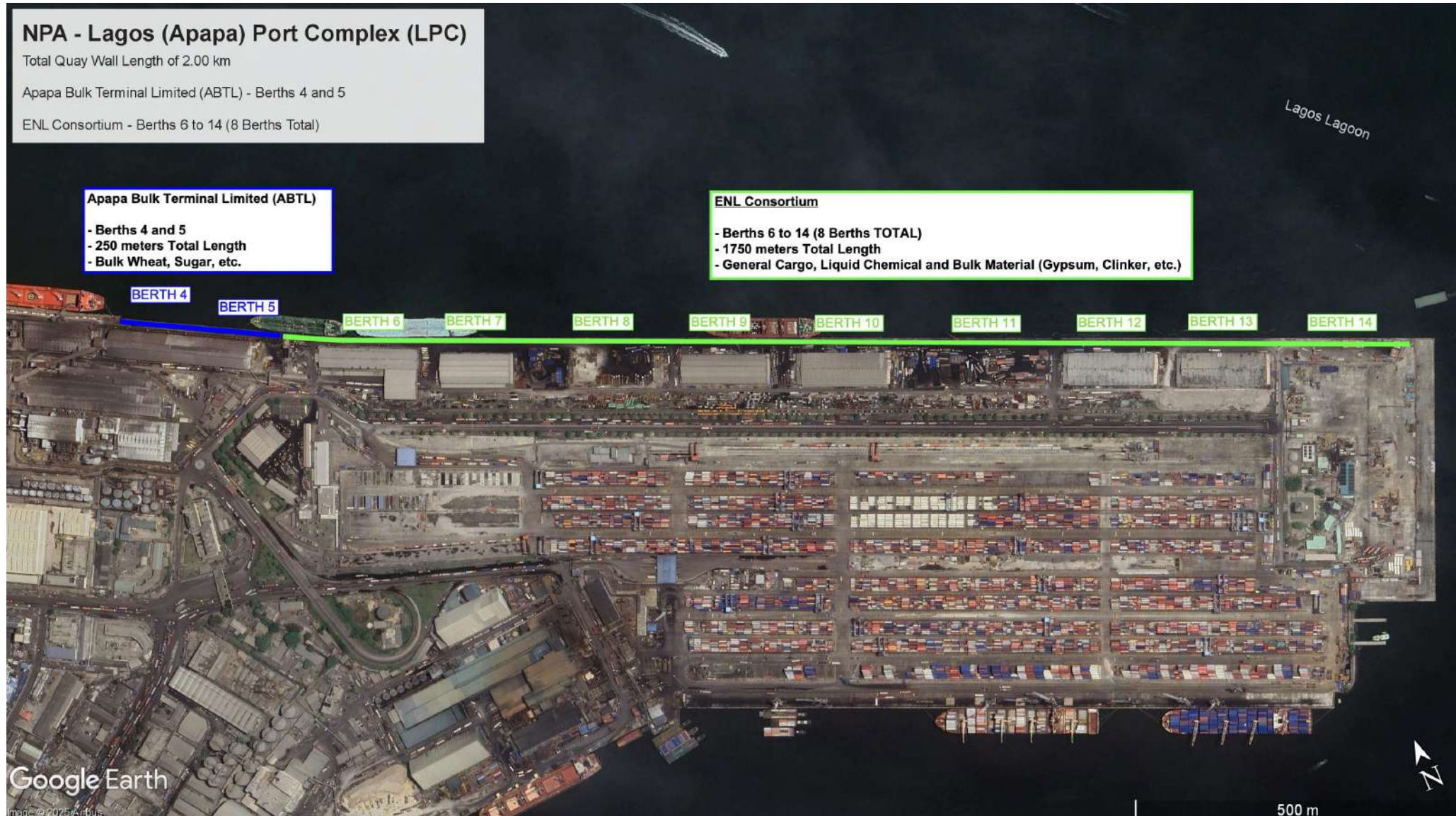
Scope of Rehabilitation

- It mainly consists of Ten (10) Berths with a Quay Wall Length of Approximately 2,563 meters.
- Additionally, the Berth Facilities (i.e. – Bollards, Fenders, Safety Landers and Apron Slab) will also be Upgraded along with a Rail Foundation for STS Gantry Cranes.

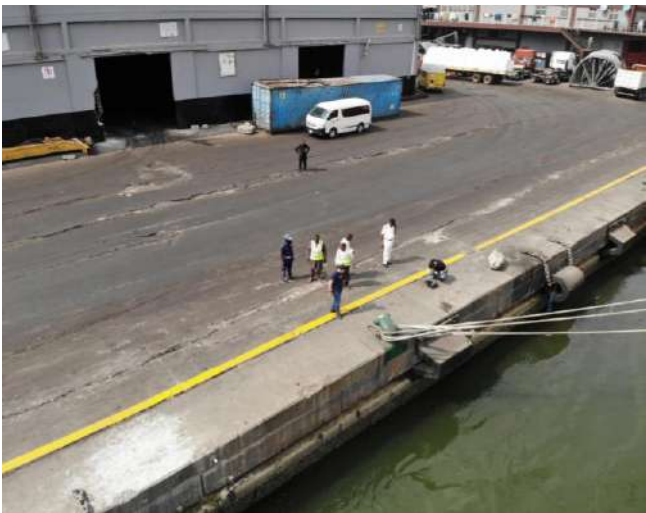

Lagos Apapa Port Complex Current State

The **Lagos (Apapa) Port Complex (LPC)** was Commissioned in **1926** following the **Construction of First Four (4) Berths**. The Quay Wall Structure is based on a **Gravity Wall Structure with a Draft Depth of 10.5 m**.

Following Approx. 100 Years of Operation, the Quay Wall Structure is showing Signs of Fatigue in the form of **Settlement of the Apron Slab and Outward Bowing of the Quay Wall**.



Scope of Rehabilitation

- The Current Scope of the Rehabilitation Works of the Apapa Port, consists of Eleven (11) Berths with a Quay Wall Length of Approximately 2.00 km. Additionally, the Berth Facilities (i.e. – Bollards, Fenders, Safety Landers and Apron Slab) will also be Upgraded.

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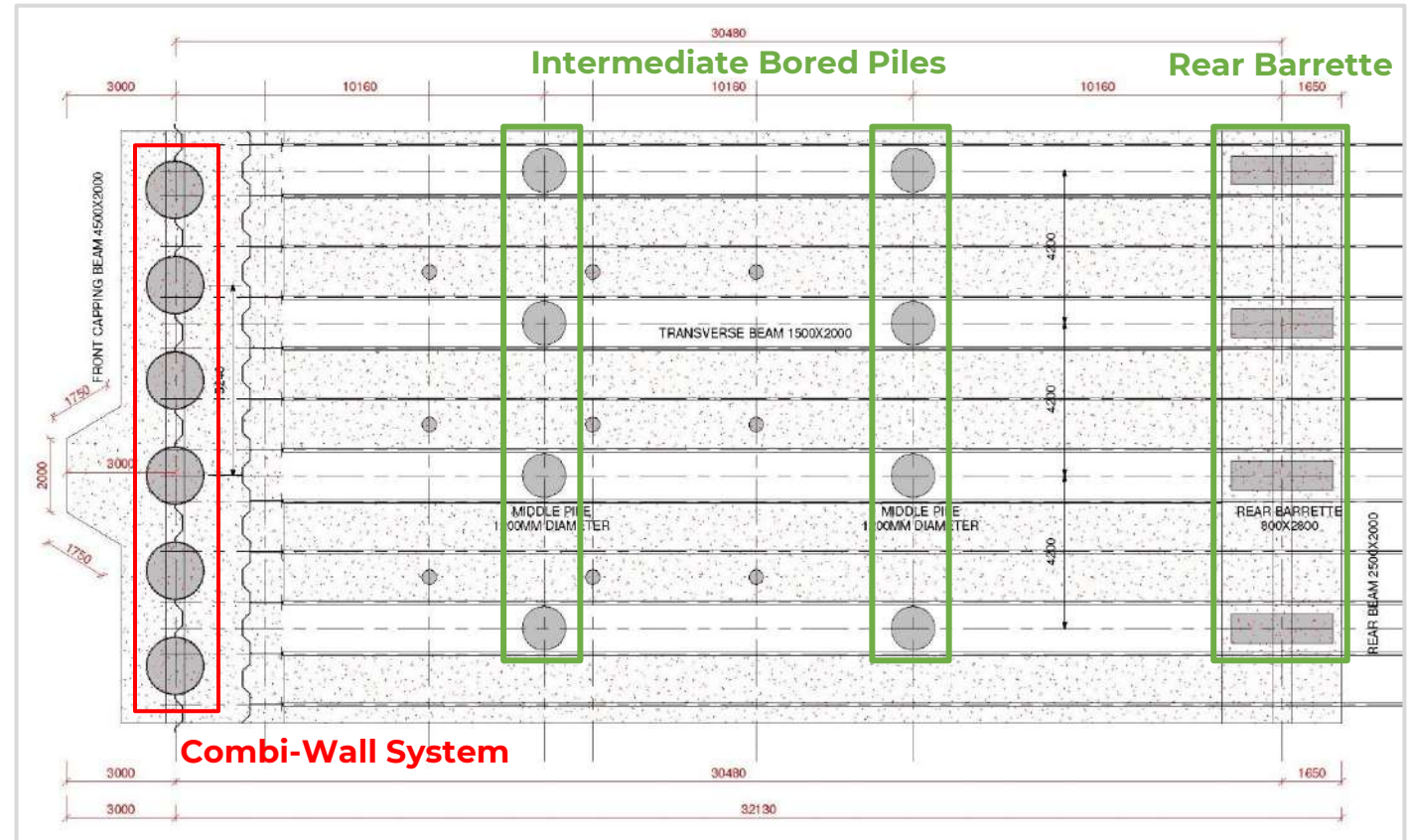
REHABILITATION'S OVERVIEW

Rehabilitation Design (1/2)

The **Rehabilitation Design** utilizes a **Combi Wall Structure** as an upgraded retaining and bearing structure to prevent any further erosion of the berth soil, the additional vertical elements include **Rear Barrettes** and **Intermediate Bored Piles**:

The combi wall system comprises of **1,600 mm Diameter Steel Cased Piles** filled with concrete and **AZ-Section Sheet Piles** in-between the circular piles is essential prevent any further erosion of the berth soil

These structural elements are vital in the **Portal Frame System** that is being utilized to connect the various vertical elements together and distribute the lateral and gravity loads.

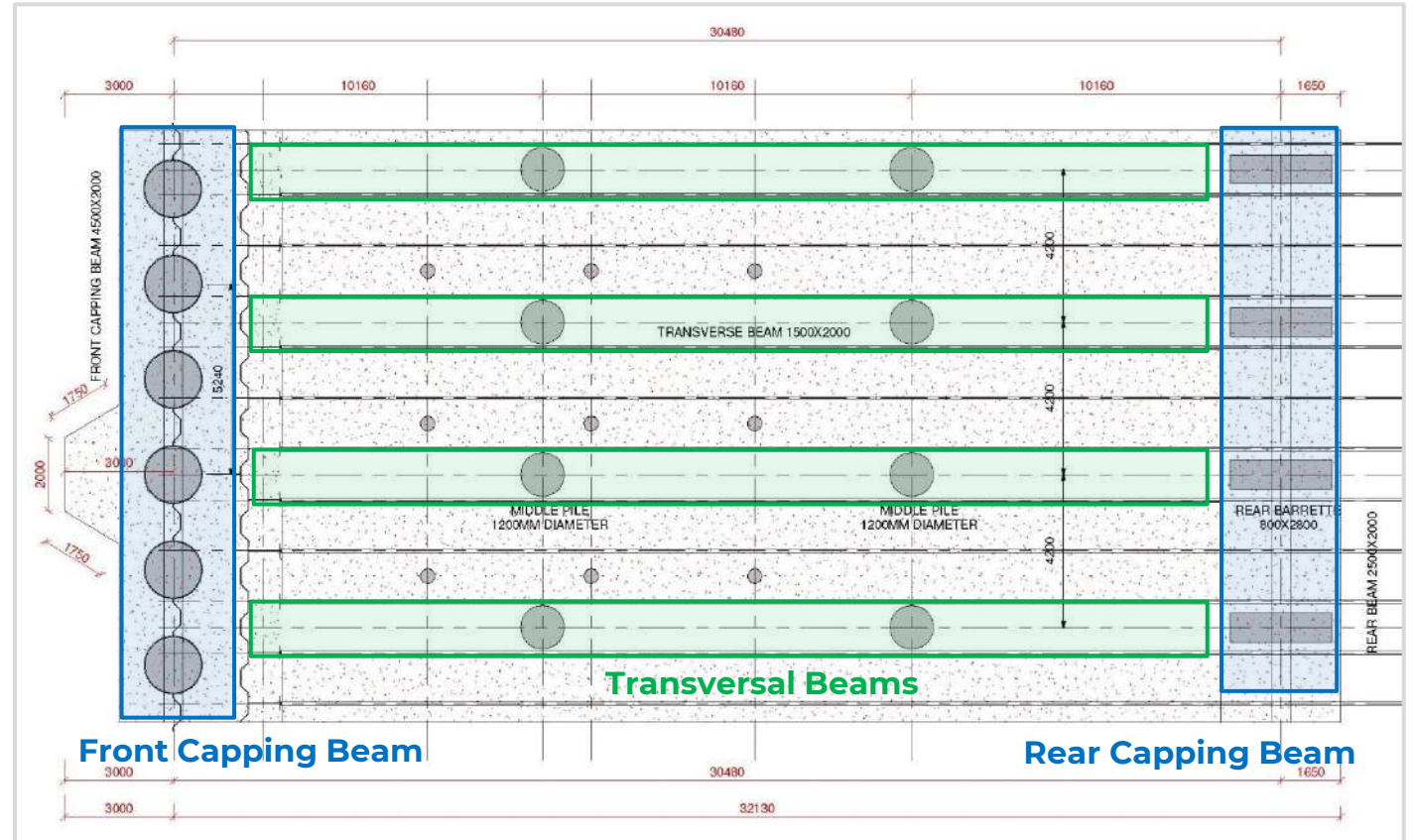


REHABILITATION'S OVERVIEW

Rehabilitation Design (2/2)

Front and Rear Capping Beams are the primary horizontal elements that are required to support the bollards, fenders, crane rails and other port facilities.

The capping beams are connected by **Transversal Beams** spaced at **4.20 m** for the bored piles to avoid the existing piles. These transversal beams complete the **Portal Frame System**.

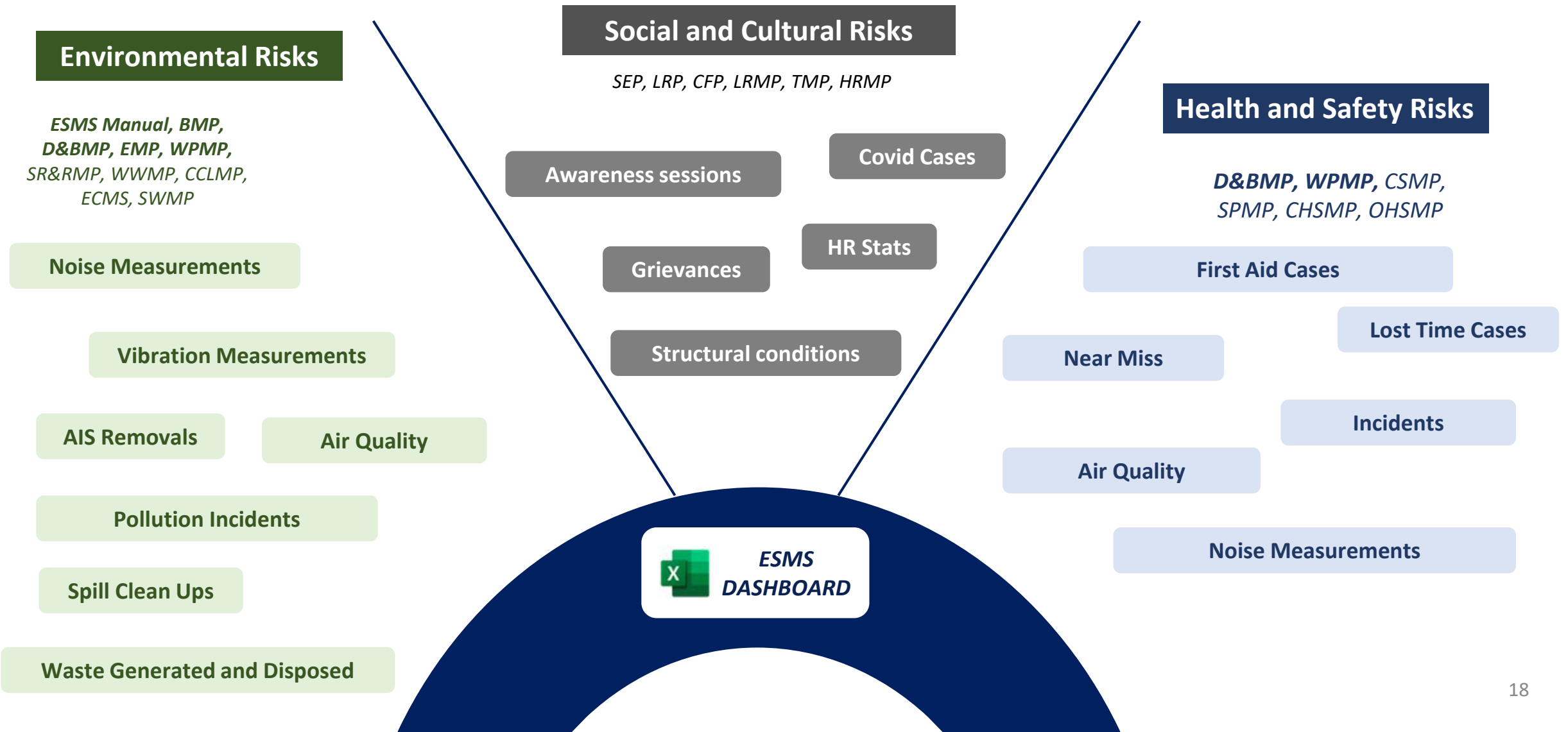

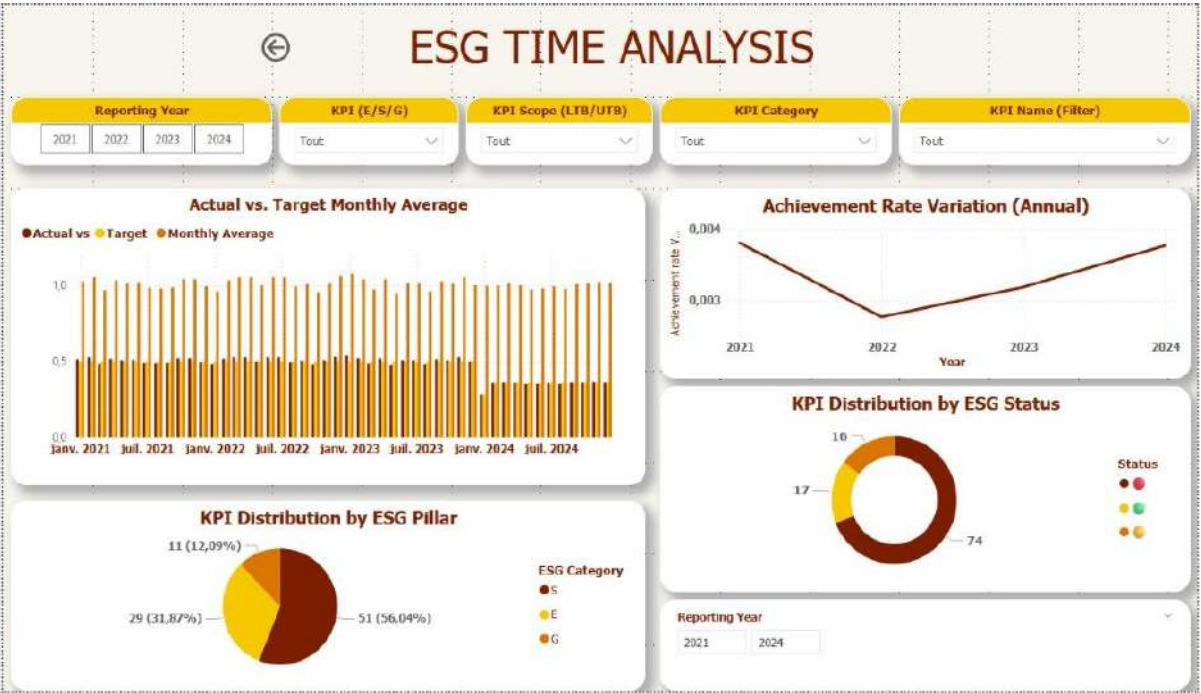

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Stakeholder's Interaction Map

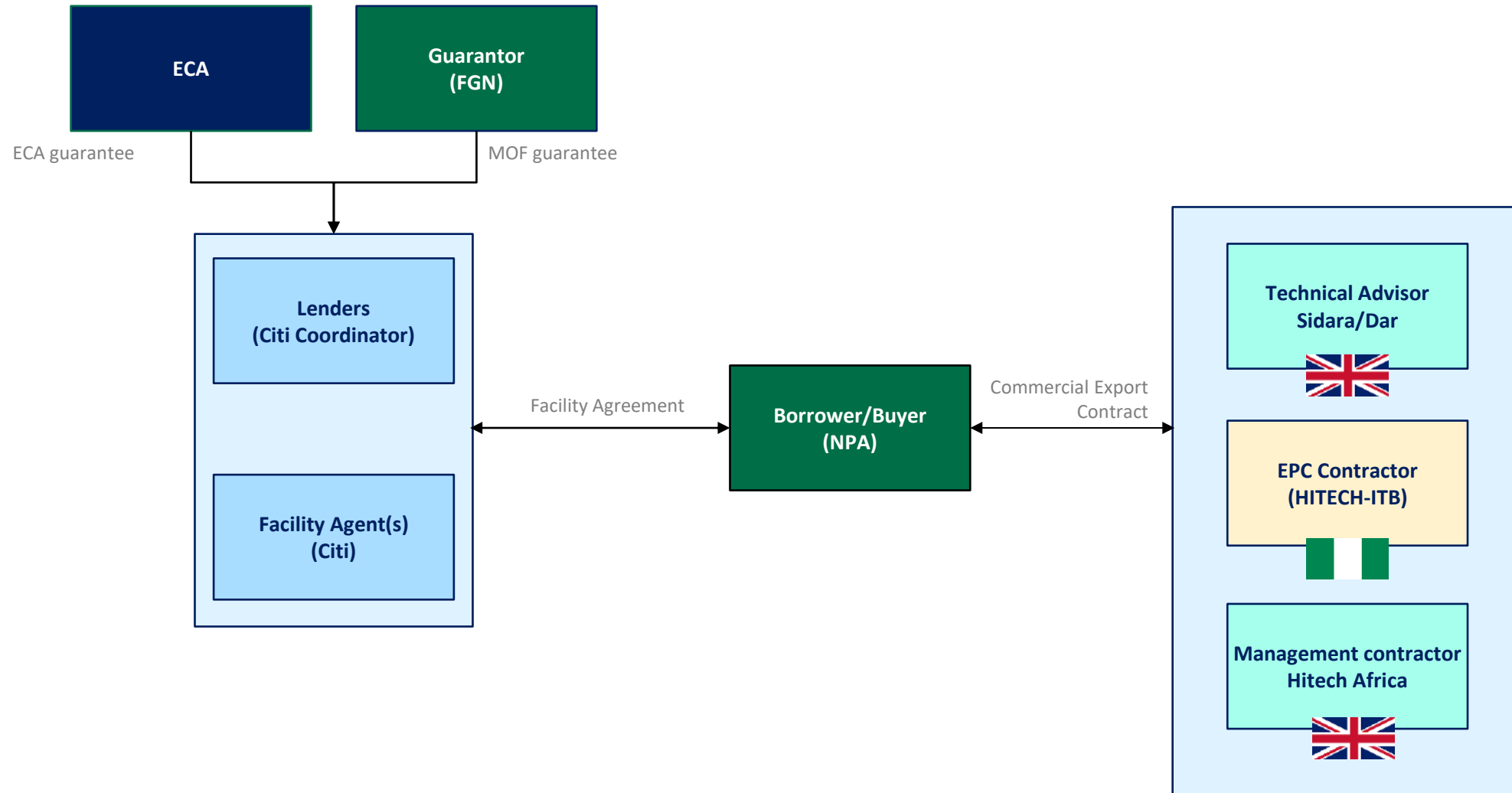

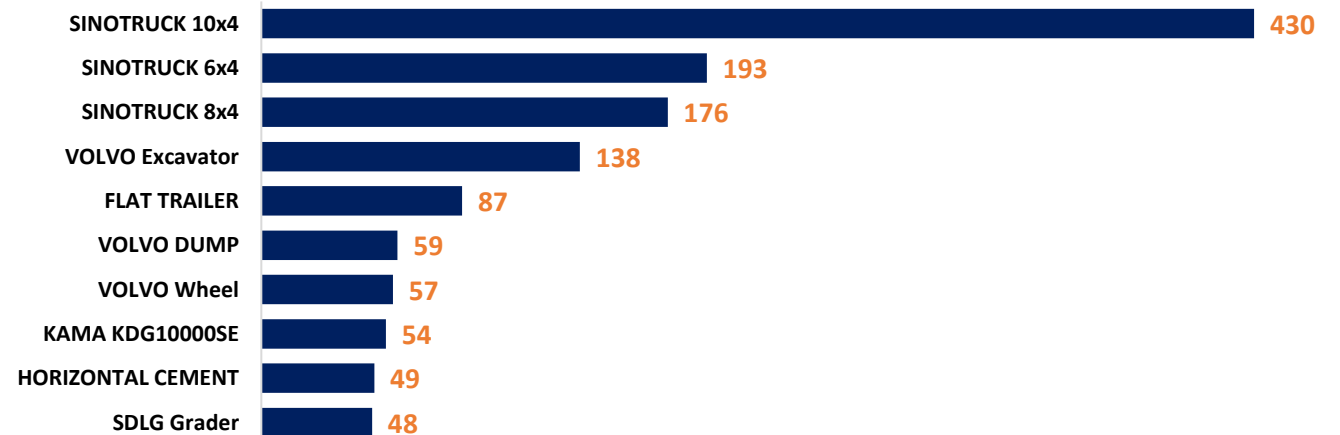
