


Summary

Imports and exports of construction and earthmoving equipment showed different trends in Q1 2024. After being on a steady downward trend last year, imports increased in Q1 above levels in Q4 last year. In contrast, exports of equipment declined in Q1 to lower levels than the previous four quarters. However, they were still at higher quarterly levels in Q1 than in the previous ten years from 2013 to 2022. Graphs 1 and 2 show UK imports and exports since 2013 based on weight of equipment shipped and the £ value traded.

Imports

In Q1 imports of equipment showed an 18% increase in tonnage shipped, reaching 82,600 tonnes, and an 11% increase in £ value, reaching £602 million. As increase in imports in Q1 2024 compared with Q4 2023 is consistent with the increase in UK sales of equipment in Q1, based on statistics in the UK Construction Equipment Data Exchange published by Systematics International. This highlighted that Q4 2023 was a low point for UK sales and Q1 2024 showed an improvement. The EU share of total imports is shown in Table 1 and is continuing to show an increasing trend. The EU share of total exports in Q1 reached 71%, following 69% in 2023 and only 57% in 2022.

Exports

Exports of equipment declined by 7% for tonnage shipped, reaching 192,700 tonnes in Q1. In £ value, exports declined by 12% reaching £1.138 million. In the last two years exports were at quarterly averages of £1.003 million in 2022 and £860 million in 2021. These were the highest years since data was collected from 2013, and illustrate that exports are still at very high levels, despite a minor dip in Q1 2024. The share of export trade to EU markets is shown in Table 1 and indicates the continuation of a slight downward trend. The EU share of total exports of equipment fell to 40% in Q1, compared with 41% last year and 44% in 2022.

Overall the UK remained a significant net exporter of construction and earthmoving equipment n Q1 2024 with exports (£1.138 million) 89% higher than imports (£602 million). This is a small increase on the 87% level achieved in 2023.

Exports of equipment by country of destination

In Q1 2024 UK exports of construction equipment were shipped to over 150 countries. Table 2 shows rankings for the top 20 countries based on weight of machines shipped (tonnes) during 2023 and 2024. In Q1 2024 the top 20 countries accounted for 85% to 90% of total exports for both £ value and tonnage shipped. The USA remained the top destination for UK exports in Q1 2024 and increased its share of total exports to just under 39% on a £ value basis. Based on tonnage shipped the USA share was just over 29% in Q1, and it remains the dominant destination for UK equipment by a significant margin.

Ireland remained in second place in the country rankings, just ahead of Poland which is continuing to show growth as an export destination. As a result, it maintained its position in third place in the ranking ahead of the Netherlands. The top four countries accounted for 52% of total exports in Q1 based on tonnage shipped, and 54% based on the £ value of exports.

Imports of equipment by country of origin

In Q1 2024 UK imports of construction and earthmoving equipment arrived from over 50 different countries. Table 3 shows rankings for the top 20 countries based on weight shipped (tonnes) during 2023 and 2024. In Q1 2024 the top 20 countries accounted for 96% to 97% of total imports in both weight and value terms. Imports from China showed significant growth in Q1 compared with 2023, overtaking the Netherlands to become the leading source on a tonnage shipped basis, after reaching fourth place last year. Germany remains the leasing source for imports based on value of equipment. A notable change in Q1 was the reduction in imports from Japan, falling to sixth place after being in second place in 2023.

Definition of equipment included in analysis of import and export statistics

The data used in this report is taken from HMRC official trade statistics, covering construction and earthmoving equipment (excluding separate trade data for components and parts). Trade data has been used from nine different HS codes, consisting of the following at the four digit level:

- 8413 concrete pumps
- 8426 cranes
- 8474 crushing and screening equipment, and concrete, mortar and other types of mixers
- 8479 machinery for public works
- 8701 track-laying tractors
- 8704 dump trucks for off-highway use
- 8705 concrete mixer lorries and pumping vehicles
- 8429 construction and earthmoving equipment including bulldozers, graders, scrapers, loaders, excavators, shovels, tamping machines and road rollers
- 8430 pile driving and pile extracting equipment, tamping and compacting machinery.



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
